He will be playing 5-man in the current 'race to 2' format, basically a best of 3 format.

When asked why now for a return, Garry had this to say “ I never really decided that I would never come back to the sport. I needed a break from the grind of tournament paintball” It was during this hiatus that Garry honed his skills in practical firearms competitions, including a 2007 Pennsylvania state championship. But what caused him to choose now? “The timing works out well, and it's benefits a great cause, how could I say no?” he answered. When asked who would benefit from this foray, he replied” Why me, of course. I really miss shooting people in the face, and here's a great chance to get out lay some hate”
